IMMIGRATION REFORM BILL AVAILABLE ON GPO'S FEDERAL DIGITAL SYSTEM

WASHINGTON – The U.S. Government Printing Office (GPO) has made available the bipartisan Senate immigration reform bill known as the *Border Security, Economic Opportunity, and Immigration Modernization Act* on GPO's Federal Digital System (FDsys). FDsys is a one-stop site for authentic, published Government information. GPO launched FDsys in January 2009 and since that time it has expanded to include 800 thousand searchable titles and experienced more than 400 million document retrievals.
