The Government of Canada is building strong, inclusive and sustainable communities by increasing infrastructure funding over the next ten years. The first phase includes new funding for public transit, social infrastructure and green infrastructure that aims to create economic growth, encourage social inclusion and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. In the coming months, we will work with provinces, territories, municipalities, Indigenous communities and other stakeholders to develop the second phase of the infrastructure plan.
