Obligation 1		
Report in person to the following local registration site address: _____		
or any other registration site in the province or territory of your main residence between 11 months and one year from your last annual registration date.		
Your next registration date shall be between:		
11 months following the registration date (yyyy-mm-dd): _____ and 1 year following the registration date (yyyy-mm-dd): _____		
Obligation 2		
Report in person or by other means as determined by the province or territory to a registration center within <b>7 days</b> after a change in your main, secondary, employment or volunteer address or location (proof of new address required).		
Obligation 3		
Report in person or by other means as determined by the province or territory to a registration center within <b>7 days</b> after a change of your given or surname (last name).		
Obligation 4		
When you register with a registration center, you must provide the following information:		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Your full legal name</li> <li>• Your gender and date of birth</li> <li>• All secondary residences</li> <li>• All employment addresses, along with the <b>type of employment</b> and <b>name of employer</b></li> <li>• Height</li> <li>• Description of every distinguishing mark (scars, tattoos, birthmarks, etc.)</li> <li>• A photograph and a set of your fingerprints may be taken</li> <li>• The licence number and the name of the issuing jurisdiction of every driver's licence that they hold</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Every alias that you use</li> <li>• Your main residence</li> <li>• The address of every educational institution where you are enrolled</li> <li>• All telephone numbers at each of these locations and all mobile (cell), and pager numbers</li> <li>• Weight</li> <li>• All <b>vehicles</b> registered to you or that you regularly use</li> <li>• The address of every volunteer activity you engage in, along with the <b>type of activity</b> and the <b>name of the person or organization</b> for which you volunteer</li> <li>• The passport number and the name of the issuing jurisdiction of every passport that they hold</li> </ul>	
Obligation 5		
If you will be absent from your main or secondary address for a period of at least <b>7 consecutive days</b> , you must report your actual or estimated date of departure <b>prior to leaving</b> . If you remain within Canada, you must provide the location and address of every place you will stay. Any changes in this information must be made no later than <b>7 days</b> after the change.		
A sex offender who is convicted of a sexual offence against a child (age less than 18) shall notify a person who collects information at the registration centre:		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• without delay before the sex offender's departure               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ the dates of their departure and return,</li> <li>◦ every address or location at which they expect to stay outside Canada</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• without delay, after the sex offender's departure               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ any change in address, location or date</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
Upon return to Canada, a sex offender who is convicted of a sexual offence against a child (age less than 18) shall disclose to the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA):		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• the date of their departure from Canada</li> <li>• every address or location at which they have stayed outside Canada</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• the date of their return to Canada; and</li> </ul>	
In addition, whether your absence is within or outside of Canada, you must also provide notification of your actual return date within <b>7 days</b> of returning to your residence.
