



Activity sheet 3 "..." Today, the Governor General

Instructions

- Your introduction must begin with the words, "Today, the governor general ... "
- The body of your presentation must answer all the questions listed under your theme.
- In your conclusion, share your personal impressions on what you have learned.

Themes and avenues of research

1. Biographical:

"Today, the governor general . . . is His Excellency the Right Honourable David Johnston."

- □ Who is Mr. Johnston (career, family, etc.)? See <u>gg.ca</u>, under the "Governor General" tab.
- □ What are the three pillars of his mandate? See the "Smart & Caring" tab.
- □ What events has he taken part in recently? See the "News and Events" tab.
- 2. Descriptive:

"Today, the governor general . . . has a number of responsibilities, which can be grouped into five fields of activity."

- □ What are these five fields of activity? See <u>gq.ca</u>, under the "Role" tab.
- □ What are his duties with regards to the Canadian Forces? See the "Role / Commander-in-Chief" tab.
- Through what types of activities does he support Canadian values, such as diversity and inclusion? See the "Role / Bring Canadians Together" tab. (Give examples of recent events.)
- 3. Reflective:

"Today, the governor general . . . meets the students at [name of school]."

□ Why does the governor general visit schools? See <u>gg.ca</u>, under the "Role / Bring Canadians Together" and the "Smart & Caring / Learning and Innovation" tabs, among others.

- □ If the Governor General were to visit your school today, what would you like him to learn about, see or discuss during his visit? Why?
- □ What would you ask him? Why?
- 4. Case study:

"Today, the governor general . . . recognizes Canadians who have made a difference in our society."

- □ What are the Canadian honours? See <u>gq.ca</u>, under the "Honours" tab.
- □ Who in your community has received a Canadian honour or a governor general's award? See the "Honours / Find a Recipient" tab. (Present a few examples.)
- □ Who do you think, in your community, deserves to receive an honour or award? Identify which honour or award they deserve. Justify your choice using the criteria listed on the <u>gg.ca</u> site, in the subsections about each honour.
- 5. Opinion piece or class debate:

"Today, the governor general . . . plays an essential role in protecting our parliamentary democracy."

- □ What are the governor general's constitutional responsibilities? See <u>gg.ca</u>, under the "Role / Constitutional Role" tab.
- □ In your opinion, have there been any incidents in recent or not-so-recent history in which the governor general had to intervene in order to ensure good governance of the country?
- □ In your opinion, what is the real scope of the powers of the Crown that the governor general can use in exceptional circumstances? See http://canadiancrown.gc.ca, under the "Diamond Jubilee / Teachers' Corner" section, the PDF file *A Crown of Maples*, chapter on "Powers of the Crown."
- □ Do you agree with the statement that "the governor general plays an essential role in protecting our democracy"? (Why or why not? Justify your answer.)

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
