The Prep

Download our app

Arrive Early

Have your boarding pass ready

The Bins



(if your boarding pass is on your cell phone, place it in your bag after it is scanned.)

Place these items in the bin:

Outerwear

Remove bulky sweaters and winter coats.

Laptop computer

Unpack it from its case.

Keep in your carry-on:

Metal items

Coins, keys, watches and jewellery.

Small electronics

Smartphone, tablet, e-reader and camera.

Liquids, aerosols and gels

Place your **1 L plastic bag** of liquids, aerosols and gels in the bin.

Exempted liquids and medicine

Medications, baby formula, breast milk

Be prepared to show them to the screening officer.

The Metal Detector



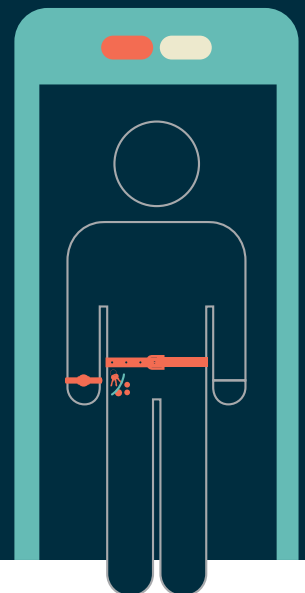
Metal items (coins, keys and even gum wrappers) **can set off the detector.** Put them in your carry-on bag.



You **may be asked** to unbuckle your **belt** and hold out the ends to either side for the screening officer to inspect.



You **may be asked** to remove your **footwear.** Some – like construction boots and high-heeled shoes – can contain metal shanks.
