Re: Complaints to the FPCC re CFC's Allocation for Period A-127

The following is to advise you that the Farm Products Council of Canada (Council) has received a joint complaint by the Canadian Poultry and Egg Processors Council and the Further Poultry Processors Association of Canada as well as a complaint by Restaurants Canada against Chicken Farmers of Canada's July 29, 2014 decision on the quota allocation for period A-127. A copy of the complaints is attached for your information.

The Council has reviewed the complaints and determined that they meet the requirements of Section 7(1)(f) of the *Farm Products Agencies Act* and has therefore accepted the complaints. A process will be initiated as outlined in Council's *March 9, 2011 Interim Complaint Guidelines*. A copy of these Guidelines is also attached for your information.

The Council would ask that you review these complaints and provide the Council with your comments by August 14, 2014. Council's Chairman, Mr. Pellerin, will be contacting you shortly to discuss timelines and process.
