
At the request of and on consent of the complainant and the respondent, the complaint mediation process between the parties and FPCC will be initiated in early August. As per FPCC's March 9, 2011, Interim Complaint Guidelines, a Notice (enclosed) was also sent to stakeholders to seek comments by July 31, 2015.

With regards to CHEP's request and in recognition of the challenges specific to the timing of this complaint, FPCC has agreed to extend the time for CHEP to submit a written response to the OBHECC complaint until July 31, 2015.
