Re: Complaint pursuant to paragraph 7(1)(f) of the Farm Products Agencies Act with regard to Turkey Farmers of Canada's decision made on June 11, 2015, and with regard to the TFC Multiplier Breeder Policy and Turkey Farmers of Ontario

Dear Mr. Spurr:

With respect to your letter of complaint dated July 10, 2015, against the Turkey Farmers of Canada (TFC), the Farm Products Council of Canada (FPCC) finds that the complaint made by Turkey Farmers of Ontario (TFO) meets the requirements of paragraph 7(1)(f) of the Farm Products Agencies Act.

As you have requested, FPCC will not proceed further with this complaint until July 31, 2015, to allow TFO and TFC to complete the process of reconsideration of the June 11, 2015, decision. After this date, in the absence of any agreement between TFO and TFC, FPCC will move forward with the complaint process as provided for in the enclosed March 9, 2011, Interim Complaint Guidelines.
