The TFC's proposal was a substantial document with many important issues raised for TFO's consideration.

I understand that TFO has held a meeting yesterday to consider the TFC proposal and TFO is planning a second meeting tomorrow afternoon. I also understand that TFO has made no final decision as yet about the TFC proposal and that the earliest that TFO might be in a position to make a decision would be late tomorrow afternoon, which coincides with the expiry of the extension granted by Council.


I understand from Mr. Spurr that the TFC proposal has thus far, been received in a very positive light during TFO's consideration.
