The following is a proposed amendment to the 2016/2017 schedule to the Canadian Turkey Marketing Quota Regulation.

This amendment further revises the Schedule to the Quota Regulation for the 2016/17 Control Period building on the previous amendments submitted on February 29, April 8, May 10, August 9 and October 11, 2016.

This proposed amendment reflects decisions that were made at the TFC 248th General Meeting of November 23 and 24, 2016, implementing a requested increase to the Section 1 Whole Bird Export Allocation.

From the relevant motions made at the TFC 248th Meeting, the proposed revised 2016/2017 federal quota for turkey, excluding the unregulated area, is as follows:

Proposed Amendment:

1. A Requested Increase to the Section 1 Whole Bird Export Allocation

It is necessary that the 2016/2017 Quota Regulation be amended to reflect an increase to the Section 1 Whole Bird Export Allocation requested by Turkey Farmers of Ontario (TFO).

a) Justification

Section 1 Whole Bird Allocations reflect the production of turkey required for forecast exports of whole turkeys. Allocations are utilized on the basis of the volume of whole birds exported on a one-to-one basis. For every kg of whole birds exported, a kg of policy utilization is earned which allows for domestic production to fully replace exports. Allocations are based on forecasts provided by Provincial Boards in consultation with exporting firms.

Under Section 1 of the Export Policy, there is no upper limit on the utilizations that can be earned on the export of whole birds. As a result, allocations for Section 1 Whole Bird Exports are set out separately from Section 1 Parts Exports in allocation tables prepared by TFC.

In response to new opportunities in export markets, an increase of 258,000 kg, for a total whole bird export allocation of 553,000 kg under Section 1 for the Province of Ontario is required.

Objects of an Agency

This proposed amendment is in response to an opportunity in an export market that producers and a processor in the Province of Ontario are in a position to fill and the functioning of the TFC's Export Policy. The amendment reflects the Agency's responsibility of promoting a strong, efficient, competitive industry. With this amendment, the TFC is adjusting allocations in response to variations in the size of the market for turkeys.
