Subject: Amendments to Canadian Turkey Marketing Quota Regulations, 1990

Dear Mr. Davies:

At its June 15, 2015 meeting, the Farm Products Council of Canada (FPCC) considered the Turkey Farmers of Canada's request for approval of the proposed amendments to the Canadian Turkey Marketing Quota Regulations, 1990 for the 2015-16 control period as submitted to FPCC on April 20, 2015.

I am pleased to inform you that Council members approved your proposal for amending the quota allocation to 406,257,825 lb (184,275,425 kg) eviscerated weight. This amendment is effective on the date of registration and expires on April 30, 2016.

In reviewing the proposed quota regulation amendments, Council members found that the amendments satisfied the requirements of the Farm Products Agencies Act, the Agency's Proclamation, the Federal-Provincial Agreement (FPA) as well as the Agency's By-Laws. Furthermore, Council members were satisfied that the volumes requested should continue to contribute to stability in prices for producers and consumers.
