Dear Mr. Davies:

At its meeting on March 23, 2015, the Farm Products Council of Canada (FPCC) considered the Turkey Farmers of Canada's (TFC) request for approval of the proposed amendments to the *Canadian Turkey Marketing Quota Regulations, 1990* for the 2015-16 control period, as submitted to Council on February 5, 2015.

I am pleased to inform you that the Council approved your proposal to amend the quota allocation to 408,430,819 lb (185,261,078 kg) eviscerated weight for the period April 26, 2015 to April 30, 2016.

In reviewing the quota regulation amendments, as well as the rationale and data provided, the Council found that the amendments satisfied the requirements of the *Farm Products Agencies Act*, the Agency's Proclamation, Federal-Provincial Agreement (FPA) and attached schedule as well as the Agency's By-Laws. Furthermore, Council is satisfied that the volumes requested will meet market requirements for all categories of quotas and result in reasonable prices to consumers.

Overall, there were sufficient grounds and information for Council to be satisfied that the amendments to the Quota Regulations are necessary for the implementation of the Agency's marketing plan.

Council expects TFC to continue to work with its stakeholders towards improving the efficiency and competitiveness of the turkey industry, particularly on promoting higher turkey consumption.
