Collared grizzly bear killed near Annie Lake

A collared grizzly bear was killed between April 27 and May 5, 2014, likely in the vicinity of Alligator Lake or the Red Ridge Trail near Annie Lake. The collar was removed and later deposited in the bush next to a pull-off commonly used for loading off road vehicles, near kilometer 15 of the Annie Lake Road.

It is unlawful to kill a collared animal without reporting the incident.

Conservation Officers are asking the public for any information concerning any hunters or other people who may have been in that area at that time or handled the collar.
