

Trusted Traveller CATSA Security Line

The Trusted Traveller CATSA Security Line (TTCSL) is a designated screening line for passengers who hold valid NEXUS cards. NEXUS is a joint Canada-U.S. program for low-risk, pre-approved travellers.

Passengers show their NEXUS card and boarding pass to enter clearly marked lines at selected airport pre-board screening checkpoints to bypass the queue and go straight to the screening line. Screening officers confirm passengers' identities by visually verifying their documents.

Having designated pre-board screening lines for NEXUS card-holders ultimately streamlines boarding for all air passengers and improves customer service and efficiency. The TTCSL is available at Ottawa, Toronto Pearson, Toronto City Centre, Montréal, Vancouver, Edmonton, Calgary, Winnipeg, Halifax, Kelowna, Moncton, Québec City, St. John's airports and Regina.

The TTCSL is an initiative involving CATSA, the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) and Transport Canada. Travellers who want to enroll in NEXUS must apply to the CBSA, undergo a rigorous risk assessment and pay a processing fee. Those approved receive a NEXUS card that is valid for five years. At airports, NEXUS card-holders who use the TTCSL must still undergo pre-board screening and comply with all security requirements.
