Fares and charges to be paid by persons with disabilities who require additional seating to accommodate their disabilities to travel by air on international flights it is economic disadvantage and does not give full participation in all aspects of society and equal access to transportation;

The disadvantage of having only disability income, this population should have the right to bring their "escort" for free, when the airline does not provide the total service in flight such as feeding, toilet, and mobility, regardless of the underlying reason for their disability.

My son is 12 years old, suffering with cerebral palsy, blind, autism, seizures and fed by tubes. We live in Toronto ON, but my whole family in Brazil.

I struggle here working full time to give him a better quality of life, without any support from family.

Trying to save money to go to Brazil to see my family to recharge and have a break, it is impossible, since I always have to buy business class, the chair on economy it is impossible for my son, to change his diapers or getting comfortable on 10 hrs non-stop flight.

Bryan requires help for everything, so it is not an option to send him by himself for vacation to Brazil without an attendant and a flight attendant will not do everything that is needed. It is not fair, that people like my son, are not able to go on vacation because of lack of money. They have the same right than everybody else, and they have no income, because they are not able to work. With only 1 income (mine) it is no possible to buy tickets.

They should re-consider human rights on Intl. Flights as well, Or have 1 -2 seats bigger with more space on the aircraft, or give some discount for the ESCORT
