My name is Tracey Mealing and I have a daughter with severe peanut/tree nut allergies. She carries an epipen. We would feel safer while travelling if the following practices were put in place:

- a) wipes available for passengers to clean drop down trays and arm rests if they desire
- b) no peanuts or tree nuts offered as snacks (the dust can travel and cause issues with those who are anaphylactic to even the dust)
- c) Epipen on board in the first aid cabinet
- d) where possible, an allergen free zone in the row in front of or behind the passenger
- e) courtesy announcement to passengers regarding the allergy and asking for their consideration.
