





Activity Sheet 5 Nominate Someone

Did you know?

Anyone can nominate someone for an <u>Order of Canada</u>, a <u>Decoration for Bravery</u>, a <u>Meritorious Service Decoration</u> or the <u>Governor General's Caring Canadian Award</u>. It is our responsibility as citizens to get involved in the nomination process to ensure that all great contributions to this country are recognized and remembered.

Part One: Write an Essay

- a) Choose someone, from your community or larger region, who you think deserves to be recognized with an honour or award.
- b) Research these honours and awards to be able to select the one that best suits the person you chose.
- c) In 500 words or so (approximately one page), make a compelling case for why you think he or she should receive this honour or award.
- d) In your introduction or conclusion, indicate how this person could be a great role model for you.

Part Two: Nominate Someone
