Dear Ms. May-Cuconato:

As per condition of license # 10, APTN is pleased to offer this summary report for 2014 – 2015 on the number of hours of French and Aboriginal language programming we offer on a weekly basis, the annual amount of English and French language programming broadcast, and the annual amount of closed captioning we offer annually on our English and French content.

Also as part of condition of license # 10, APTN will provide information on the number of minutes of advertising and infomercial time we broadcast.

- APTN broadcasted 23.5 hours per week of French language programming and 1222 annually between the hours of 6a-12a. This is based on the East feed.
- APTN broadcasted an average of 52 hours per week of Aboriginal language programming and 2704 annually between the hours of 6a-12a. This is based on the north feed.
- APTN broadcasted 4394 hours of English language programming annually (between the hours of 6:00 a.m. 6:00 a.m.) 100% of which was closed captioned.
- APTN provided 1222 hours of French language programming annually (between the hours of 6:00 a.m. 6:00 a.m.) 100% of which was closed captioned.
- APTN abides by the 12 minutes per hour of paid advertising.
- APTN broadcasted infomercials between 4:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. nightly. In addition, a one hour block of infomercials ran at 11:00 a.m. on Sunday's.



As well, per condition # 11, APTN is pleased to report on our independent production activity detailing name of production, production company, whether it is "related", region of production, length of production in episodes and running time, and budget of production (in confidence).

Both an abridged version and a confidential version with budget information is attached for your review.
