Administrative renewals

1. The Commission **renews** the broadcasting licences for the radio programming undertakings listed in the appendix to this decision, from 1 December 2004¹ to 30 June 2005, subject to the terms and conditions in effect under the current licences.
2. The applications for the renewal of these licences were published in Broadcasting Public Notice CRTC 2003-55, 1 October 2003 and Broadcasting Public Notice CRTC 2004-37, 2 June 2004. However, the Commission will not be able to rule on these applications before the current licences expire.
3. This decision does not dispose of any substantive issue that may exist with respect to the renewal of these licences. The Commission will issue decisions on the renewal applications at a later date.
