## CFLN-FM Goose Bay – New transmitter at Northwest River

- 1. The Commission **approves** the application by Newcap Inc. to amend the broadcasting licence for the English-language radio programming undertaking CFLN-FM Goose Bay, Newfoundland and Labrador, to add an FM transmitter at Northwest River. The Commission did not receive any interventions in connection with this application.
- 2. The transmitter will operate at 95.9 MHz (channel 240LP) with an effective radiated power of 50 watts (non-directional antenna with an effective height of antenna above average terrain of 22.2 metres).
- 3. The licensee stated that the addition of the new transmitter would allow it to adequately serve the population of Northwest River.
- 4. The Commission reminds the licensee that pursuant to section 22(1) of the *Broadcasting Act*, this authority will only be effective when the Department of Industry (the Department) notifies the Commission that its technical requirements have been met and that a broadcasting certificate will be issued.
- 5. Given that the technical parameters approved in this decision are for a low-power unprotected FM service, the Commission also reminds the licensee that it will have to select another frequency if the Department so requires.
- 6. The transmitter must be operational at the earliest possible date and in any event no later than 24 months from the date of this decision, unless a request for an extension of time is approved by the Commission before 7 February 2013. In order to ensure that such a request is processed in a timely manner, it should be submitted in writing at least 60 days before that date.
