

Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing in June 2017 to consider an application from Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) to amend the nuclear power reactor operating licences for the Darlington Nuclear Generating Station (NGS) located in the Municipality of Clarington, Ontario and the Pickering NGS located in the City of Pickering, Ontario.

The proposed amendments would add to the Pickering and Darlington nuclear power reactor operating licences activities that are currently authorized under a nuclear substance and radiation device licence to import and export nuclear substances in contaminated laundry, packaging, shielding or equipment. OPG has also requested additional licensed activities, which would allow contaminated laundry from the Western Waste Management Facility to be combined with Pickering laundry before it is shipped to the United States.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider this application. The requested changes are administrative in nature and do not raise matters related to the protection of health, safety, security or the environment that would warrant being considered in a public hearing. The Commission will consider written submissions from OPG and CNSC staff.

The hearing submissions are not available on the CNSC website and must be requested through the Secretariat at the coordinates below.

Following the deliberations and Commission decision on this matter, a *Record of Decision* will be published on the CNSC website at nuclearsafety.gc.ca and made available to the public on request.
