Step onto the ice confident in your ability to encourage participation amongst your athletes while helping them have fun!

The Coach Stream clinic focuses on getting your players moving in the right ways and enjoying themselves while introducing them to the sport of hockey. You will also learn the fundamentals of fitness and how to be a positive role model to your athletes.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Upon completing this clinic you will be trained to:

- Use HOCKEY CANADA resources to plan on/off-ice activities;
- Communicate effectively with players, parents, officials and league administrators;
- Encourage participants and work within fair play guidelines;
- Conduct safe, effective and age-appropriate on-ice practice drills;
- Apply an ethical decision making process.

CLINIC STRUCTURE

This is an 8-hour in-classroom clinic with an optional on-ice session.

PRIOR LEARNING

You may be asked to complete a fun and easy “pre-task” workbook to help kick-start your learning*.

EVALUATION AND CERTIFICATION

Upon completion of this clinic you will be considered *In-Training*. Submitting the “post-task” **Mentor Journal Evaluation** will give you *Community Sport – Trained* status. To receive *Community Sport – Certified* status you will need to complete the **Make Ethical Decisions (MED) Online Evaluation**.

- **Safety First**
