## CONTEXT:

In order to arrive at a specific recommendation for actual per diem amounts, a more detailed analysis was carried out using actual 2012-13 meeting data (meeting schedules, types and duration of meetings, and attendance records).

- The total amount of fees paid in 2012-2013 was \$ 189k (or an average of \$21k per member), of which 70% was attributable to Board meetings and 30% to committee meetings; yet, out of a total of 44 hours of meetings, only 45% of the time was devoted to Board meetings while 55% of the time was for committee meetings.
- Currently, conference calls are paid only at 1/8 of the per diem for board meetings (the
  government scheme is 1/4) and committee attendance is remunerated at 1/2 of the board
  fee (the government scheme does not have a lower rate for committee meetings). Also,
  Board and committee meetings in excess of a specified number (4 or 6 meetings) are
  remunerated at a reduced fee (the government scheme does not reduce the rate after a
  specified number of meetings).
- Streamlining the fee schedule to harmonize it with the government scheme (by providing
  for a full per diem for committee meetings, setting conference calls at 1/4 of the per diem
  fee, and eliminating the reduced amounts for extra meetings) will increase the total
  envelope by 34% and provide an average fee per member of \$28k.
- A fee increase based on the rate of inflation since 2001 (representing a 27.6% increase), coupled with the streamlining of the fee schedule, will result in an envelope increase of 75% and an average fee per member of \$36k.
- Any increase in fees payable to Board members will require an equivalent increase in the budget to which Board meeting fees and expenses are charged to.

## **RESOLUTION:**

That the Human Resources and Governance Committee recommend to the Board that Schedule "K" of the Bylaws be amended by:

- (a) Replacing Sections 1, 2 and 4 with the following:
  - "1. Pursuant to Sub-section 51(1)(a) of the Broadcasting Act, the per diem fee payable to directors, other than the Chairperson of the Board and the President, for the attendance (including participation by video-conference) at meetings of the Board and its committees, shall be \$....., provided that:
    - (a) Only an amount equivalent to one-fourth of the per diem fee shall be payable when a meeting is held by conference call;
    - (b) Committee Chairpersons shall receive an additional amount of \$...... for each Committee meeting chaired;
    - (c) Audit Committee members shall receive an additional amount of \$..... for each Audit Committee meeting attended;
    - (d) The fees above shall be increased annually on April 1st by an amount equivalent to the increase in the Consumer Price Index from the previous calendar year; and
    - (e) All calculated amounts shall be rounded to the nearest \$10."; and
- (b) Renumbering the other sections accordingly.

### **APPENDIX 1**

## SCHEDULE "K" - DIRECTOR COMPENSATION

Current Revision: March 31, 2006

#### (The Resolution amends the underlined text)

- 1) The fees set out in this schedule apply to Governor-in-Council part-time appointees.
- 2) Subject to section 3, each Director shall be paid a fee of
  - <u>a)</u> \$2000.00 per day for attendance at each regularly scheduled Board meeting (to a maximum of six in any fiscal year), and \$625.00 per day for attendance at any additional Board meetings;
  - b) \$1300.00 per day (\$1550.00 for the Committee Chair) for attendance at any regularly scheduled Audit Committee meeting (scheduled independently from the board meetings and to a maximum of six in any fiscal year) and \$625.00 per day for attendance at any additional Audit Committee meetings scheduled independently from the Board meeting;
  - c) \$1000.00 per day (\$1250.00 for the Committee Chair) for attendance at any regularly scheduled Committee meeting other than the Audit Committee (to a maximum of four days in any fiscal year) and \$625.00 per day for attendance at any additional Committee meetings;
- 3) A Director is entitled to be paid only one meeting fee for each day (24 hour period), even if the Director attends more than one meeting during that day.
- 4) Each Director shall be paid a fee of \$250.00 each time he or she participates in a meeting by means of telephone or other communication facility as authorized by Section 50(3) of the Broadcasting Act, provided that if a meeting in which he or she so participates is a regularly scheduled meeting of the Board at which other Directors are personally present, the Director shall be paid a fee of \$625.00 per day or \$312.50 per half day while he or she so participates.
- 5) Each Director shall be paid out-of-pocket expenses each time that he/she is required by the Corporation to be its representative at a social or other function.
- 6) Each Director shall be paid either a per diem at the approved CBC daily allowance rate to cover incidental expenses incurred while attending a meeting of the Board, one of its committees, or otherwise engaged on the business of the Corporation; or the actual reasonable expenses incurred.
- 7) Each Director shall be reimbursed for all transportation costs (including travel costs to and from an airport) while attending a meeting of the Board, its committees, or otherwise engaged on the business of the Corporation.
- 8) The Chairperson is entitled to be paid reasonable travel and living expenses incurred by him/her while engaged on the business of the Corporation at any place other than his/her normal place of residence.
