- SARTEC represents writers of original French-language literary or dramatic works intended for radio and television broadcast, film, and audiovisual purposes.
- The parties must renew their collective agreement, which expired on July 9, 2012.
- The collective agreement aims to establish minimum levels of compensation for writing work and its use (broadcast of texts).
