COURTCALL TELEPHONIC APPEARANCES

Effective May 2009, CourtCall the company which originated the regularly scheduled telephonic court appearance program will serve as the provider of telephonic court appearance services for the Court of Queen's Bench of New Brunswick.

Voluntary CourtCall Telephonic Court Appearances are now allowed for matters before both Trial and Family Divisions the Court of Queen's Bench of New Brunswick pursuant Rule 37.09 or other judicial directive for appearances by telephone conference call.

AS EACH JUDGE'S USE MAY VARY, CONTACT COURTCALL FOR DETAILS.

Counsel may make a CourtCall Appearance as follows:

- 1. NOT LESS THAN THREE (3) COURT DAYS BEFORE THE HEARING DATE, serve and file with CourtCall (not the Court!) a Request for CourtCall Telephonic Appearance (available from CourtCall);
- 2. Pay a fee of \$49.00 US/ \$55.00 CAN to CourtCall, LLC.

A confirmation from CourtCall, LLC, will be e-mailed to your office upon the filing and payment outlined above.

A CourtCall Appearance is made as part of a participating Courtroom's usual calendar. Unless notified to the contrary, all counsel who have timely filed their Request and have paid the fee may appear by dialing the toll-free teleconference number provided by CourtCall, LLC. A pre-hearing check-in will occur five minutes before the scheduled hearing time.

A CourtCall Appearance is voluntary and may be made without consent of the other party or advance consent of the Court. The Court, however, reserves the discretion to require personal appearance.
