An inspection body shall not be a part of a legal entity that is engaged in design, manufacture, supply, installation, purchase, ownership, use or maintenance of the items inspected. The inspection body shall not be linked to a separate legal entity engaged in the design, manufacture, supply, installation, purchase, ownership, use or maintenance of the items inspected by the following: 1) common ownership, except where the owners have no ability to influence the outcome of an inspection; 2) common ownership appointees on the boards or equivalent of the organizations, except where these have functions that have no influence on the outcome of an inspection; 3) directly reporting to the same higher level of management, except where this cannot influence the outcome of an inspection; 4) contractual commitments, or other means that may have an ability to influence the outcome of an inspection.
