**ENDORSEMENT**

**Honourable Harry Slade, Chairperson**

A Case Management Conference (CMC) was held in person on July 3, 2014, at 11:20 A.M., Pacific Time (Vancouver).

[1] The Claimant shall prepare an Amended Declaration of Claim and provide it to the Respondent. If the Parties agree on the proposed amendments, the Claimant shall file two copies of the Amended Declaration of Claim to the Registry along with the Respondent's written

consent respecting the same on or before August 29, 2014. One copy shall highlight the additions and deletions in red, and another copy will be clean. If the Parties cannot agree on the proposed amendments, they shall advise the Tribunal in writing to cause the said amendments to be discussed at a later CMC.

[2] The Respondent shall file an Amended Response to the Amended Declaration of Claim within 30 days after the filing of the Amended Declaration of Claim, should it be necessary.

[3] The Parties shall exchange Amended Lists of Documents on or before July 18, 2014.

[4] The Claimant shall provide will-say statements to the Respondent on or before August 29, 2014.

[5] The next CMC shall discuss dividing the hearing of this Claim into evidentiary (documentary, expert and *viva voce*) and legal submissions phases.

[6] The Registry shall contact the Parties in order to set a date for a CMC in September 2014.
