Birdstone will be given. Once an agreement is reached, the Parties shall advise the Tribunal in

writing. If the Parties are unable to reach an agreement, a CMC will be scheduled in short order

to address this issue before the viva voce evidence hearing.

[4] The Parties shall discuss their views on at which phase of the Claim issues related to the

apportionment of liability should be addressed, subject to any relevant determinations of the

Federal Court of Appeal in Williams Lake Indian Band v Her Majesty the Queen (Court File No.

A-168-14).

[5] The Claimant shall compile a list of First Nations to whom a notice pursuant to Section

22 of the Specific Claims Tribunal Act should be provided. This matter will be discussed at the

next CMC.
