Bonaventure Expressway Several night work in the Pierre-Dupuy / Des Moulins Road sector from November 4 to 8

Longueuil, November 4, 2019 – The Jacques Cartier and Champlain Bridges Incorporated (JCCBI) wishes to inform road users that various night work will be carried out in the area of Pierre-Dupuy and Des Moulins Road from November 4 to 8.

Details of the closure

- + Complete closure of Des Moulins Road access ramp to the Bonaventure Expy. toward downtown, from Monday, November 4 (10 p.m.) to Tuesday, November 5 (5m.) A detour via the local network will be in place.
- + Alternate closure of Des Moulins Road with the presence of signalers, from Tuesday, November 5 at 10 p.m. to Wednesday, November 6 at 5 a.m. and from Wednesday, November 6 10 p.m. to Thursday, November 7 5 a.m.
- + Complete closure of Exit 3 (Carrie-Derick St.) toward Samuel De Champlain Bridge, from Tuesday, November 5 10 p.m. to Wednesday, November 6 5 a.m.
- + Complete closure of Pierre-Dupuy Avenue, under the Bonaventure Expy., from Thursday, November 7 9 p.m. to Friday, November 8 5 a.m.

Note that this work could be postponed because of unsuitable weather conditions.
