



Assumptions:

- For Conditions requiring consultation with Indigenous Groups and commercial fishers, the Operator is required for conducting that consultation.
- For Conditions requiring consultation with other Federal departments, the C-NLOPB will contact those departments on behalf of the Operator.
- Timelines provided are estimate and are informed by previous experience in conducting compliance monitoring and verification of CEAA 2012 Decision Statements.

Additional Notes

1. The Ministerial Condition will be incorporated by the C-NLOPB as a condition of their OA.
2. Compliance monitoring and verification may include an onsite visit to the drilling installation during the drilling program
3. Examples of deliverables required under Section 2 to be submitted and accepted following the completion of drilling:
 - Results of fish and fish habitat follow up monitoring program (within 60 days, section 6b)
 - Results of marine mammal and sea turtle monitoring (within 90 days, section)
 - Results of underwater sound monitoring (within 90 days, section 6c)
 - Results of migratory bird follow up monitoring program (within 90 days)
 - Physical environmental monitoring data (within 90 days)
