**Subject: CSO Approval of the Volume of Stored Explosives Onboard The Hebron Platform**

We have reviewed your letter dated June 23, 2022 and approve your request to increase the total amount of explosives stored onboard the Hebron platform to a maximum of 200 kg during periods of well perforation activities, in lieu of the maximum quantity (75 kg) as specified by section 153 (1)(c) of the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Occupational Health and Safety Regulations*.

This approval is subject to all of the mitigations listed in the request for approval and for greater certainty, is subject to the following conditions:

1. The shipments will be timed such that explosives will remain onboard for as short a period as is reasonably practicable.
2. The quantity of explosives stored on the Hebron Platform is not more than that required for the operation.
3. The *Schlumberger Explosives Control Procedure for Hibernia and Hebron Platforms* will be adhered to at all times. Any changes or updates to this procedure shall be identified to the C-NLOPB.
4. The amount of explosives onboard is recorded on the daily reports submitted to C-NLOPB.

Please ensure that this approval letter and the application letter are provided to the Workplace Committee and posted publicly at the workplace.
