The Chief Safety Officer concurs with the Applicant's, the owner of the West Aquarius, proposal to use *DNV-OS-C301 Stability and Watertight Integrity (January 2001)*, *International Maritime Organization Code for the Construction and Equipment of Mobile Offshore Drilling Units (2009 MODU Code)*, and comply with *NMA Regulations 20.12.1991 No. 878 concerning stability, watertight subdivision and watertight / weathertight closing means on mobile offshore units* for maximum angle of heel requirements in lieu of the Installation Regulation requirements 56(10)&(13).
