The Chief Safety Officer accepts the Applicants, the owner of the *Hebron Installation*, proposal to use wood products for certain applications according to Hebron procedures and fibre-reinforced grating on cerrtain escape routes and non-escape walkways in lieu the requirements prescribed by the Petroleum Offshore Installation Regulations Subsection 19(i),49(2). The following conditions apply:

- 1. The inventory of wood volumes is kept as low as possible.
- 2. Fibre-reinforced grating is not installed in areas that have a risk of produced hydrocarbon fires.
