

Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer approves the Applicant's, the owner of the *West Hercules*, use of *Det Norske Veritas' DNV Standard for Lifting Appliance*, for the design and construction of the *West Hercules* cranes, as well as *DNV-OS-E101* and *DRILL (N)* notation for drilling production hoisting equipment. Maintenance and operation of the *West Hercules* cranes are to be in accordance with the manufacturer's requirements, *DNV Standard for Lifting Appliance*, and *International Labour Organization (ILO) Convention 152*.

The standards noted above are used for the design, construction, operations, and maintenance of the cranes onboard the *West Hercules* in lieu of Section 16 of the *Newfoundland Offshore Petroleum Installations Regulations*, which states *every crane on an installation shall (a) be designed and constructed in accordance with American Petroleum Institute Spec 2C, Specification for Offshore Cranes; and (b) be operated and maintained in accordance with American Petroleum Institute RP 2D, Recommended Practice for Operation and Maintenance of Offshore Crane*.
