

**Decision:**

The Chief Safety Officer concurs with the Applicant, the operator of the Terra Nova FPSO, to use a transponder on its dynamic positioning system that has been approved and certified by the International Electrotechnical Commission System for Certification to Standards Relating to Equipment for use in Explosive Atmospheres (IECEX) in lieu of equipment that has been approved by Underwriters Laboratories Inc. (UL), Factory Mutual Research Corporation (FM) or Canadian Standards Association (CSA) as long as the conditions of certification as noted on the IEC Ex Certificate of Conformity are complied with.
