The Chief Safety Officer authorizes the applicant, the operator for the Hebron project, to use the CAN/CSA-ISO 1990x series of standards in lieu of the CAN/CSA S47x series of standards as outlined in their proposal for the design of the gravity base structure. The authorization to use the CAN/CSA-ISO 1990x series of standards should not be interpreted to mean that a particular mode of development (i.e. a gravity-based structure) has been accepted for use in the Hebron Development. Such determination is a Development Plan Approval..
