## Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer accepts the Applicant's use of *International Maritime Organization of Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS) 1974 Convention* as amended and *Det Norske Veritas (DNV) Rules for Classification of Ships* for the manual activation of fire pumps and for the location of alarms indicating the activation of the fire pumps in lieu of the requirements of automatic activation provided the control room is manned 24/7 by 2 or more Dynamic Positioning (DP) operators who are trained in the activation and operation of the fire pumps.
