

## Chief Safety Officer Decision (Temporary Exemption)

## Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer grants the applicant a temporary exemption from the requirement for a combined carrying capacity for survival craft of 200% of the total number of persons onboard the installation until such time a permanent solution is implemented and, in any event, no later than June 30, 2015. The existing arrangement of 150% capacity based on a maximum of 100 persons-on-board and a weight of 100 kg per person is approved subject to the following provisions:

- 1. A dedicated standby vessel will be available throughout the duration of the program.
- 2. Helix Well Ops UK Ltd. to perform drills on a regular basis with all offshore personnel for evacuation scenarios.
- 3. There shall be no intrusive maintenance work and no hotwork conducted during well intervention operations.
