## Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer authorizes the Applicant, the operator for the Husky Wellhead Platform, to use the CAN/CSA ISO 1990x series of standards for the design of the Wellhead Platform in lieu of Canadian Standards Association CSA-S47x series of standards.

The authorization to use CAN/CSA-ISO 1990x series should not be interpreted to mean that a particular mode of development (i.e. a gravity-based structure) has been accepted for use in the White Rose Extension Project. Such a determination is a Development Plan Amendment Approval.
